Practical details

The course begins each year in September and the deadline for completed applications is 30th June.

The annual course fee is £575, which, for United Reformed Church members, may be reduced to £475 with signed confirmation of their Church's support.

Fees may be paid quarterly.

Financial support is often available from local churches, Synods and a bursary fund.

TLS Courses are for members of any denominations, aged 18 and upward.

Completion of the TLS Foundation Course (or a comparable alternative) is a required prerequisite for this course on some but not all pathways.

How it works

5 home study units each Term

5 local study group meetings each term with an appointed Local Tutor.

4 residential weekends.

Practical projects chosen by you.

Support network chosen by you.

The course is among those validated by a university and may contribute to a Higher Education Certificate or Foundation Degree in Contextual Theology.
